CLUB NOTES

SINCE the inception of our club in 1912 we have supplied Wales with many notable players for International matches, but no selections have given club or public greater satisfaction than those announced this week.

Paul and Lucas have played with such a high degree of skill that they commended themselves strongly to the Welsh selectors. We now have five internationals serving the club—Feeney and O'Driscoll (Ireland) and Paul, Lucas and Richards (Wales). And indications are that both countries will be interested in even more of our players shortly.

The Swans have now won five matches in a row, scoring fifteen goals without reply—a very creditable performance, traceable to their sound play and to the magnificent spirit which exists. At Port Vale we were opposed to a very fast and strong side, and even if the manner of our scoring was not as clear-cut as it has been in the past, there was no questioning our pronounced superiority in actual football skill.
