



# VISITORS

## PORT VALE PEN PICTURES 1993-94

OUR VISITORS by COLIN JONES

### PAUL MUSSLEWHITE (Goalkeeper)

Born - Portsmouth 22nd December, 1968. First choice keeper who cost £20,000 from Scunthorpe in July 1992. Tall and commanding in the area, he made the position his own from early last season and helped the club to reach Wembley twice, gaining a winners medal in the Autoglass Trophy. He began his career with Portsmouth but did not make a Senior Appearance for them, moving to Scunthorpe on a free transfer in 1988.

### TREVOR WOOD (Goalkeeper)

Born - Jersey 3rd November 1968. Signed on a free transfer from Brighton in July 1988 making his debut three months later against Huddersfield in which he kept a clean sheet. His best season was 1990-1991 when he established himself as the clubs regular keeper since then he has only made a handful of appearances and this season will be hoping to regain top spot.

### BERNIE SLAVEN (Striker)

Born - Paisley 13th November 1960. Experienced goalscorer who surprisingly joined the Vale on a free transfer from Middlesbrough in March 1993. He soon settled in and after scoring the goal that took the club to Wembley for the Autoglass final he scored the winner in the final itself. Capped seven times for the Republic of Ireland he began his career with Morton and then had short spells with Airdrie and Queen of the South before becoming Scotlands leading scorer in 1985 with Albion Rovers. This brought him to Middlesbrough's attention and he topped their scoring charts for six successive seasons before losing his place last season. He is now approaching 200 career goals.

### DEAN GLOVER (Defender)

Born - Birmingham 29th December 1963. Cultured central defender who cost £200,000 from Middlesbrough in February 1989 helping the club to win promotion four months later. He has been a regular member of the side ever since, missing only a handful of games and part way through last season became club skipper, going on to lift the Autoglass Trophy in the clubs first Wembley

appearance. He began his career with Aston Villa helping them to reach the semi-finals of the Milk Cup in 1986 and then after moving to Boro' helped them to promotion in 1988. Has also played for Sheffield United on loan.

### PETER BILLING (Defender)

Born - Liverpool 24th October 1964. Tall central defender who originally joined the Vale on loan from Coventry City in February 1993 as cover, but he did well enough for the move to become permanent three months later for £35,000. He began his career with non-league South Liverpool and then moved on to Everton and Crewe Alexandra before arriving at Coventry in 1989 for £120,000.

### DARREN HUGHES (Defender)

Born - Prescot 6th October 1965. Speedy left back who joined the Vale in September 1987 for £10,000 from Brighton after a spell on loan. He began his career with Everton helping them to win the FA Youth Cup in 1984 and then moved on to Shrewsbury where he operated mainly in midfield. He missed the whole of last season through injury but is now hopeful of regaining full fitness.

### RAY WALKER (Midfield)

Born - North Shields 28th September 1963. Former England Youth International who is now the clubs longest serving player having cost just £12,000 from Aston Villa in August 1986. A classy midfielder, he also had a loan spell at the Vale in September 1984 and has been one of the clubs best players in recent years, winning the clubs player of the year award in 1988 and 1991 and also being in PFA divisional teams on three occasions. He helped the club to promotion in 1989 but unfortunately missed the Autoglass Trophy final last season through injury. Is now in the top ten of the clubs all-time appearance records.

### KEVIN KENT (Midfield)

Born Stoke on Trent 19th March 1965. Despite being locally born he didn't join the Vale until March 1991 from Mansfield - with Gary Ford and £80,000 going the other

way. Since then he has been in and out of the team in a variety of roles and also occupied a roving right back role last season as he became a regular over the second half of the campaign. He was a member of the victorious Autoglass Trophy Final line-up for the second time in his career having previously done so with Mansfield and he has also played for West Bromwich Albion and Newport, appearing in all four divisions.

### ROBIN VAN DER LAAN (Midfield)

Born - Schiedam (Holland) 5th Sept. 1968. Strong Midfield player with an eye for a goal who became the clubs first venture into the overseas market in February 1991 when he cost £80,000 from the now defunct Dutch team Wageningen. He was an instant hit as a striker with 4 goals in 10 games but since then he has largely occupied a midfield role. He has scored some important goals including the winner at Stoke in the Autoglass Trophy and he was a member of the Final winning side. Began his career with SSV Schiedam his home town team.

### MARTIN FOYLE (Striker)

Born - Salisbury 2nd May 1963. Became the clubs record signing in June 1991 when he cost £375,000 from Oxford and he made a good start with two goals on his debut against his old club. Top scorer in 1991-1992 with 16 goals but last season he was hampered by a variety of injuries and is

now ready to put all that behind him. Began his career with Southampton before moving to Aldershot and has now scored goals in all four divisions.

### NICKY CROSS (Striker)

Born - Birmingham 7th February 1961. Joined Vale in June 1989 for £125,000 from Leicester City and did well in his first season scoring 15 goals. Injury then hampered his progress for two years but he returned with a bang last season notching 12 goals and playing his part well in the clubs successful campaign. He began his career with West Bromwich Albion and then moved to Walsall for whom he scored 51 goals in 2 1/2 years.

### NEIL ASPIN (Defender)

Born - Gateshead 12th April 1965. Wholehearted player who always gives his all. He joined the Vale for £140,000 in July 1989 from Leeds where he had spent seven years and played in the First Division at the age of 16. He has hardly missed a game since, winning the player of the Year award in 1990.

### PETER SWAN (Defender)

Born - Leeds 28th September 1966. Tall central defender who cost a fee of £300,000 from Hull City in August 1991. Began his career with Leeds, joining Hull for £200,000 in 1989 and in two years as a striker notched 25 goals but he is now settled at the back where he is rock solid.


